Highest Temperature: 136°F in El Azizia, Libya, on September 13, 1922.

Lowest Temperature: -129°F in Vostok, Antarctica, on July 21, 1983.

Most Abrupt Temperature Change (U.S.): -4°F to +45°F in 2 minutes in Spearfish, South Dakota on August 29, 2936.

Highest Wind Speed: 231 mph in Mt. Washington, New Hampshire, on April 12, 1934.

Greatest 12-Month Rainfall: 1,042 inches in Cherrapungi, India, on August 1, 1860 - July 31, 1861.

Most Rainy Days (U.S.): 335 days per year in Mount Waialeale, Kauai, Hawaii.

Lowest Average Annual: 0.03 inches in Arica, Chile.

24-Hour (U.S.): 43 inches on [unknown date] in Alvin, Texas.

Greatest Amount of Snowfall 12-Month (U.S.): 1224.5 inches in Paradise Ranger Station, Washington.

Greatest 24-Hour (U.S.): 74 inches in Silver Lake, Colorado, on April 14-15, 1921.

Largest Hailstone Stone (U.S.): 1.67 pounds, 7.5 inches in diameter in Coffeyville, Kansas, on September 30, 1970.
